At this time the world's media offers us regular updates regarding the devastation brought on by the Israel-Hamas war in Gaza. People there are in

need of peace, and the most basic necessities.



We remain mindful too of the Syrian families who continue to live in tents in the Bekaa Valley in neighbouring Lebanon. It is 13 years (2011) since they were forced to flee their homes.

Natural disasters have also reeked havoc, including the Mw 7.8 earthquake that struck southern and central Turkey and northern and western Syria on February 6th 2023. This killed tens of thousands of people, flattened wide areas of cities and sent the entire region, which was already grappling with a refugee crisis and over a decade of war, into a monumental recovery effort.
